Many beginners looking up at the night sky know that our solar system is made up of very large objects such as stars and planets. They may even know that some planets are circled by smaller moons, but do they know that other objects—ones looking quite different from moons—can be seen in our solar system, too?

A "shooting star" in the clear night sky is actually a small piece of space rock called a meteor. Its bright streak of light is made when the burning rock enters the earth's atmosphere. A few of these objects actually hit the earth, and then they are called meteorites.


